Scopus is the largest abstract and citation database of peer-reviewed literature and quality web sources with smart tools. It facilitates collaboration, rewards innovation and generates higher content value. Important features of the Database include:

- ✚ More than 60 million records,
- ✚ Over 21,500 peer-reviewed journals, Over 360 trade publications,
- ✚ Publications from more than 5,000 international publishers,
- ✚ Articles-in-press from more than 5,000 title,
- ✚ More than 1,30,000 books, available in Scopus and 10,000 added each year,
- ✚ Plus, more than 1100 Book Series containing over 34,000 individual volumes
- ✚ **Coverage years** : Back to 2003 for all subject areas
- ✚ **Book types** : Monographs, edited volumes, major reference works, and graduate level text books
- ✚ **Scopus tools** : H-Index, Citation Tracker, Author Identifier, Affiliation Identifier & Journal Analyzer
